

EX: OWNING A PIECE OF A BIG PIZZA

STOCKIMARKET

A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE BUY
AND SELL SMALL PARTS OF
COMPANIES, CALLED STOCKS
OR SHARES.

GROWTH INVESTING: INVESTING IN A COMPANY FOR ITS FUTURE GROWTH POTENTIAL

STOCK EXCHANGE: PLACE TO BUY AND SELL STOCKS



ASSETS: A USEFUL OR VALUABLE THING OWNED BY A PERSON OR COMPANY

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS: INCOME STATEMENT, BALANCE SHEET, CASH FLOW STATEMENTS

MARKET CAPITALIZATION: THE TOTAL VALUATION OF A COMPANY AND SELL STOCKS





BULL MARKET: WHEN STOCK PRICES ARE RISING OR EXPECTED TO.

BEAR MARKET: WHEN STOCK PRICES ARE FALLING.

S&P 500: A STOCK MARKET INDEX THAT TRACKS THE PERFORMANCE OF 500 OF THE LARGEST PUBLICLY TRADED COMPANIES IN THE U.S.

BLUE CHIP STOCKS: SHARES OF LARGE,
WELL-ESTABLISHED, AND FINANCIALLY
SOUND COMPANIES LIKE APPLE, MICROSOFT,
GOOGLE, AND MORE



CAPITAL GAINS: PROFIT MADE FROM SELLING
A STOCK AT A HIGHER PRICE THAN
PURCHASED.
